PROPERTY UPDATE

Cleanup day (August 26): Thanks to the families and friends that came to help. (FYI: Volunteering to help with indoor and outdoor tasks has saved CLC > \$5,000 year to date!)

- The storage shed door and trim were repaired & painted.
- Many of the large parking lot cracks were repaired first with sand and then with an asphalt patching product - (more cracks repair is needed)
- The Daycare room overhead lights were cleaned and new bulbs installed
- Restrooms were cleaned
- The Janitor room storage floor was outlined and labeled for shared Daycare use.
- Hooks/nails removed from pergola
 10 wheelbarrows of weeds & overhanging branches were removed from the playground area.

Our next cleanup date will be October 21 where we will do fall cleanup: Tasks include: OUTSIDE- trim bushes, mulch where needed, remove a tree too close to the church. Or INSIDE - wash windows or help organize/ clean closets!!!

Other repairs: The West Wing ceiling air unit stopped working. SE Mechanical was contracted to complete the repair. After numerous unsuccessful attempts to repair due to faulty parts, they negotiated w/Carrier for a <u>free</u> new 2022 model which was installed on 9/1. Stone was added for base leveling and damper pads installed which were not previously installed. What a great blessing!!

CLC has rented out the West Wing to Jennifer Cook who has been working with her family to prepare for the opening of child care. Local inspections were conducted and passed; the state inspection is now scheduled to occur on Tuesday, October 10th.

Once the state inspection is passed, it is anticipated that Ms. Jenny's Faith & Learning FUNdamentals for infants and preschoolers will be opened for business, hopefully during the month of October!

Currently, Ms. Jenny is looking to hire two more child care workers, and she is available to give tours to prospective families as enrollment is partially filled.
